**Minutes of a meeting of the Planning & Transport Committee held on
22 March 2011 at Callicroft House, Rodway Road, Patchway.**

1. APOLOGIES

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. Woodley.

2. DECLARATION OF INTEREST

The Chairman stated that Councillors must declare their interest under the Model Code of Conduct in any matter to be discussed, either at the beginning of the meeting or when it is raised during the meeting.

3. MINUTES

The minutes of the last meeting held on 22 February 2011 were agreed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

a) Chelford Grove

The following was reported:

- SGC not agreed to carry out the requested work: advisory white lines to protect residents' drives; strips of different coloured tarmac or changed surface to restrict traffic speed; current costings for repairs to the footway and private forecourts. SGC had stated that to install illuminated warning signs for pedestrians at each end of Chelford Grove would cost £3,000 if the Town Council would like to pay for them. The Committee decided not to proceed with this suggestion.
- Cllr. Alsop stated that he had arranged a meeting with Streetcare the following day to show them the large number of potholes in Stoke Lodge.

5. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Committee objected to the following planning application on the grounds of over-development of the site:

Eason Court
28 Kestrel Close

Two storey and single storey extensions
to block of flats to form lobbies and
additional living accommodation

The Committee noted that the following application had been granted by SGC:

171 Gloucester Road

Single storey rear extension

6. OTHER MATTERS RAISED

a) Street Care Meeting

The Clerk reported that she had a meeting the following week with the head of Street Care and a number of items were agreed to be raised for action. These included potholes in Stroud Road and the condition of the rubber ramps in Coniston Road.
