1. Apologies

8. Matters raised by Councillors or Clerk

a) Coniston Road

Cllr. Gordon had received confirmation from the highways engineer that interactive signs would be erected in Coniston Road so that the information on closures was up to date.

The Clerk would report the information that some of the shuttle buses in Coniston Road did not have tail lifts for disabled access.

b) British Legion Club

c) Wind damage

d) Asda & Ice-skating rink applications
