21/12/2021 - No 5 To approve the minutes of the Patchway Town Council meeting held on Tuesday 16th November 2021 and to note any issues.

It was noted that over £3 million will be invested into creating facilities that are large enough to cope with the demands that the development has had on the Town. Councillors felt that Patchway Town Council had made substantial progress and were now getting things done for their residents. The Council noted that the communication with residents was now improving through social media as well as the noticeboards.

RESOLVED: It was agreed by a majority, with one against, that Patchway Town Council do not agree that there should be a new Parish Council for Charlton Issues and that Patchway Town Council will continue to integrate the communities with the support of the whole Council. The Clerk would draft a consultation response and send it to the Chairman and Vice-Chairman for approval prior to submitting the document.
